Underage Drinking Citations

If you have been cited for an Underage Drinking violation, you have the following options:

- A. If you wish to contest this charge, you must either appear on the listed court date and time to enter a "Not Guilty" plea at your initial court appearance OR file a written "Not Guilty" plea with the Douglas County Clerk of Courts prior to your initial court appearance.
- B. If you do not wish to contest the charge and want to pay the fine that is noted on your citation, you may do so prior to your court date by notifying the Douglas County Clerk Of Courts. Be advised that your Driver's License will be suspended for 60 days for the first offense and will increase for any future drinking violations.

PLEASE NOTE:

If this is your FIRST offense for Underage Drinking and you do not wish to contest this charge but also do not wish to lose your driving privileges, you have the option to appear at your assigned court date and time and enter a "Guilty" or "No Contest" plea. At that time, you must notify the Court that you wish to attend an alcohol education class offered through the University of Wisconsin-Superior at a cost to you of approximately \$100.00. With the successful completion of the class, your Driver's License will not be suspended and there will be no further fines or penalties.
